

Call for Visiting Professors / Guest Lecturers



Kiel University of Applied Sciences announces a programme for visiting professors and guest lecturers from the summer term 2021 to the winter term 2023. The programme is intended to promote international exchange in teaching and research, to offer students a greater variety of lectures and classes and to strengthen cooperation with its European partner universities. The programme also aims to serve Internationalisation@Home. Beginning with the summer term 2021, visiting professors/guest lecturers can teach at one of the six faculties (at two locations) or at the Centre for Languages and Intercultural Competence (ZSIK) for one or two terms. The summer term runs from 1 March to 31 August and the winter term from 1 September to 28/29 February.

What we have to offer:

- A temporary visiting professorship with an employment contract based on pay grade BesGr W 2 or a guest lectureship with a temporary employment contract and, if the academic requirements are met, a classification up to salary group 13 TV-L
- Teaching experience at Schleswig-Holstein's largest University of Applied Sciences with practical relevance, an impressive strength in teaching and research and international networking
- Support by the respective faculty and the International Office.

Our expectations:

We expect our visiting professor/guest lecturer to contribute to the internationalisation of Kiel University of Applied Sciences. He or she will complement the regular curriculum with internationally oriented classes, represent his or her home university and thus enable students to gain access to internationality on the campuses in Kiel or Osterrönfeld.

Your duties:

The teaching load for visiting professors is 18 hours per week in the respective faculty and 22 hours per week for guest lecturers over a period of 28 weeks per year. Participation in research projects is desirable for visiting professors.

To participate in the programme, the following requirements must be met:

- You are currently working at one of our Erasmus partner universities
- Visiting professors must be eligible for appointment to professorships at Universities of Applied Sciences in Schleswig-Holstein according to the current version of the Higher Education Act (HSG), i.e. they must have completed a full course of university education and hold a PhD and they must have gained five years professional experience, including at least three years outside the higher education sector
- Guest lecturers at the ZSIK must have completed a relevant university degree
- You live and work abroad in the EU and have a valid EU work permit
- You will receive a leave of absence from your home university stating that you have no teaching obligations at your home university for the duration of your stay abroad at Kiel University of Applied Sciences.
